SUBJECT : Weekly Accomplishment Report of Provincial Agriculture Office covering the period

March 31 to April 4, 2014

Hereunder are the highlights of our office accomplishments to wit:

Total of 28,325 hectares of rice area were harvested yielding 119,814.75 metric tons as of March 28, 2014
Served as Resource Person and facilitator in the conduct of Grand Field Day of Chinese Hybrid Rice Adaptability Trial Techno Demo at Cabaritan, San Manuel (Daniel Tumamao's Farm).
Served as resource person in the conduct of Farmer Led Extension (FLE) technology demonstration Field Day in the municipality of Sta Maria.
1. Total area harvested to corn as of March 31, 2014 is 70,244.29 hectares with a production of 309928.62 metric tons obtaining an average yield of 4.58 metric tons per hectare.
Served as facilitator in the conduct of Corn Techno Demo Field Day at Tumauini, Isabela.

III HIGH VALUE COMMERCIAI CROPS DEVT PROGRAM (HVCCDP)

A. Nursery Operation and Management

- 1. Produced 215 pieces of asexually propagated sweet tamarind seedlings.
- 2. Distributed 134 pieces of assorted fruit tree seedlings to 8 beneficiaries.
- 4. Produced 13,000 pieces (pepper & eggplant) vegetable seedlings
- 5. Distributed 3550 pieces of eggplant vegetable seedlings to 41 beneficiaries and 4,200 pieces of pepper seedlings to 50 recipients.

B. Greenhouse Operation

1. Monitored status of vegetable seedling production and distribution of joint DA-LGU Greenhouse Project. A total of 33,529 pieces of assorted vegetable seedlings were produced by Greenhouse operated by Luna, San Agustin and Santiago benefitting 948 constituents of their respective municipalities.

C. Coffee Production

1. Monitored crop stand and stages of coffee production established under the Convergence Project of DA-LGU partnership. A total of 79,719 trees were planted in 35 barangays Involving 259 farmers of Angadanan, Cordon, Echague, San Guillermo and Santiago already at flowering and vegetative stage. Idle and unproductive lands are the sites identified for the convergence project.

A. San Pablo Fish Farm Operation

- 1. Produced 115,000 pieces tilapia fingerlings.
- 2. Dispersed 112,000 pieces of fingerlings to the Naguilian SFR project and fishpond operators of LGU Sta. Maria, Sto. Tomas and City of Ilagan.
