II. CORN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

a. Sustainable Corn Production in Sloping Areas (SCOPSA)

DA-Initiated Technology demonstration project using Sloping Agricultural Land Technology (SALT) approach to improve soil fertility and control soil erosion causing nutrient depletion. For Wet Season 2014, the 3.0 hectares demo site is located at Brgy. San Lorenzo, involving Ilagan City cooperators.

The SCOPSA project site at Brgy San Lorenzo, City of Ilagan is at reproductive stage and undertook regular crop maintenance activities.

b. Farmers-Scientist RDE Training Program

is three-phase RDE lt а methodology of transferring agricultural technologies to develop values of farmers engaged in corn-based production system in adopting scientific and sustainable method of farming. The project is located at Mozzozin Sur, Sta. Maria where 8 groups are from 48 selected organized farmer participants . Specific trial is given to each group to undertake. The 8 trials to be given emphasis of study:

- 1. Integrated Pest Management
- 2. Detasseling
- 3. Population Density
- 4. Varietal trial
- 5. Germination Trial
- 6. Land Preparation
- 7. Fertilizer trial
- 8. Corn-based Intercropping

c. Farmer –led Extensionist Technology Demonstration

Demonstration project promoting yield boosting technologies in corn production through trained farmers as extension workers
