Hereunder are the highlights of our office accomplishments to wit:

ACCOMPLISHMENT
Continued field monitoring on status of planting activities of farmer recipients provided with certified seeds covered by the 2014 Early Wet Rice Production Program in the municipalities of Roxas, San Manuel, Aurora, Burgos, Ramon, San Isidro, Cauayan City, Alicia, Ramon & Santiago City.
 Assisted in the establishment of Farmers Scientist RDE Program learning site at Sta. Maria. Consolidated MLGU reports having a total of 44,229 hectares planted to corn for Wet Cropping Season.
 Produced 8,600 pieces of eggplant vegetable seedlings. Distributed 6,950 pieces of pepper, eggplant and tomato vegetable seedlings to 50 beneficiaries. Produced 646 pieces of cacao fruit tree seedlings. Distributed 105 pieces assorted fruit tree seedlings to 14 recipients. Gathered fruit tree planting materials for propagation at the Provincial Nursery
