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Post Training Evaluation on Basic Family Planning eLearning Course for Physicians Date: December 5-7, 2017 Venue: 16 municipalities of Isabela

Out of 20 selected participants for the **"Basic Family Planning eLearning Course for Physicians"** piloted in the province of Isabela, 16 were able to attend the training last October 4, 2017 and undergo the FP eLearning course for Physicians. Despite setbacks, they were able to complete the course evaluation focusing on the management of complications on using the modern methods of Family Planning wherein the platform ran for 4 weeks. Afterwhich a review and evaluation of entry plans by trained Physicians by Mr. Alison Perez, Luzon Health Project's and RTI International was conducted last November, together with the Provincial FP Program Coordinator.

As part of the monitoring status of entry plans, actual visit to the health facility was made last December 5-7 in the different rural health units and hospitals: Jones, San Isidro, Echague, Cordon, Cabagan, Quirino, Cabatuan, San Mateo, Alicia, Cauayan, San Mariano, Benito Soliven, Naguilian, CHO Ilagan I, Cauayan District Hospital and Gov. Faustino N. Dy Memorial Hospital. With the measures in place in all health facilities, Isabelenos are assured of quality and accessible Family Planning services!

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LOCAL HEALTH SYSTEM (LHS) REGIONAL VALIDATION AND AWARDING Date: Dec 1, 2017 and December 15, 2017 Venue: IPHO-FHS, Isabela

Integral to the achievement of Philippine Health Agenda (PHA) goals and targets is ensuring that Local Government Units (LGUs) have a shared vision in strengthening health systems to increase the efficiency and effectiveness in delivering basic health care services. There is a need to promote the PHA goals and targets and engage the LGUs by motivating them to direct their efforts and resources towards attaining better health outcomes.

This direction paved the way for the "Search for Outstanding LGUs for LHS Awards which aims to create a systems-based method of recognizing good performing LGUs thus making their contributions in attaining health reform goals.

Systems-based approach is built on the idea that the component parts of a system can best be understood based on its relationship with each other and other systems. By using cohesive criteria in selecting outstanding LGUs in reforming health, it creates an environment for LGUs to be comprehensive in making an impact on its priority health issues.

In addition, this endeavor encourages LGUs to be efficient on the use of their resources and aim at targeting priority health programs through health system reforms. It is then strongly believed that this will provide insights to LGUs on how a systems-based approach in health reform implementation creates greater impact and improves efficiency. Hence, LGUs will focus their efforts on improving the whole health system rather than on specific programs.

In line with this, the DOH-Regional Office Assessment and evaluation committee visited IPHO-FHS last Dec. 1, 2017 to validate the Self-Assessment Form filled up by LGUs pertaining to health system indicators reflected in the LGU Scorecard such as governance, financing, human resource and service delivery. As a result of the thorough validation made, the province of Isabela emerged as the winner of the most coveted award- the **AWARD OF EXCELLENCE**, for the province' local health systems on December 15, 2017 during the 1st Regional Local Health Systems Awarding Ceremony at Villa Blanca Hotel, Tuguegarao City.
