The Commission on Population (POPCOM) identified the symbolic babies across the country last July 27, 2014 as a demographic event and an institutional reality-check that the country was then registering a 100-million population record.

The birth of **JC M. Zipagan of Masipi East, Cabagan Isabela** was the Isabela's symbolic baby and who represented the 100-million population of the country. As he turns four (4) this year, it is guided with the theme: **"Sa Ika-apat na taon, Pagtataguyod sa Pangkalahatang Kapakanan ni Baby"**.

This year gift giving activity was done again as a manifestation of concerted efforts and supports from the Commission on Population RO II, Department of Health RO II, Provincial Government of Isabela thru the Provincial Health Office and Local Government Unit of Cabagan, Isabela.

Through solicitation from other agencies of the province and private individuals, the following were provided to the baby and his family namely: school supplies, clothing, jerry cans, toilet bowls, mosquito nets and hygiene kits. This yearly gift giving activity ensures the provision of the basic needs of the symbolic child and further to monitor the progress of his growth, well-being and total development.

The Provincial Government of Isabela in its continuing stand to combat Dengue Fever through the Provincial Health Office- Field health Services Under the Provincial Health Officer II, Doc. Nelson O. Paguirigan initiated a Dengue Meeting attended by the Municipal Health Officers of Isabela and Chief of hospitals from the provincially-maintained hospitals.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 19
DECLARING 15 AUGUST 2018, WEDNESDAY, A NON-WORKING HOLIDAY IN ALL GOVERNMENT AND NON-GOVERNMENT OFFICES IN THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA FOR THE CONDUCT OF "TODAS DENGUE, TODO NA 'TO' (IKALIMANG KAGAT)" MASSIVE CLEAN-UP ACTIVITIES TO ELIMINATE MOSQUITO BREEDING SITES AND STOP THE SPREAD OF DENGUE FEVER AND OTHER MOSQUITO-BORNE DISEASES
WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to uphold the people's constitutional right to life and implement programs that promote public health and safety;
WHEREAS, in 2011, the Department of Health issued DOH Memorandum 2011-0235 for the nationwide implementation of "Aksyon Barangay Kontra Dengue (ABKD)";
WHEREAS, the ABKD employed a communication strategy called 4S that echoed four messages to the public: 1) Search and Destroy of breeding sites, 2) Seek early consultation, 3) Self-Protection, and 4) Say Yes to fogging only in hotspot areas where increase in cases is registered for two consecutive weeks;
WHEREAS, despite the nationwide implementation of ABKD in accordance with DOH Memorandum 2011-0235, Dengue Fever continues to cause severe health, social, and economic impacts in the 81 provinces where Dengue is endemic, including the province of Isabela;
WHEREAS, with the recent onset of the rainy season, Isabela health authorities have observed a continuing rise in the number of dengue fever cases in Isabela, with 1,054 cases reported by the Provincial Health Office as of 09 August 2018, and 5 deaths occurring in the municipalities of Tumaunin, Santo Tomas, Delfin Albano, Benito Soliven, and Gamu;
WHEREAS, the rising number of Dengue Fever cases has prompted the DOH to issue Administrative Order No. 2018-0021 dated 25 July 2018, stating the need to shift the focus from primarily containing outbreaks to taking steps to increase collaboration and coordination within and beyond the health sector and reduce the impact of the disease in communities and among the youth, specifically the 0 to 14 age bracket from which almost 79% of deaths are reported to have come;
WHEREAS, on the whole, AO 2018-0021 converted the 4S communication tool into a Control and Prevention Strategy applicable to all DOH offices, local government units, government and non-government organizations, public and private hospitals, and the private sector, and also provided for the *Guidelines for the Nationwide Implementation of the Enhanced 4S Strategy against Dengue, Chikungunya, and Zika*;
WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Isabela which is the only LGU in the country with the most comprehensive and multi-sectoral anti-Dengue Campaign dubbed as "*Todas Dengue, Todo Na 'To*," shares the DOH perspective to intensify efforts to reduce the incidence of Dengue Fever and other mosquito and water-borne diseases;

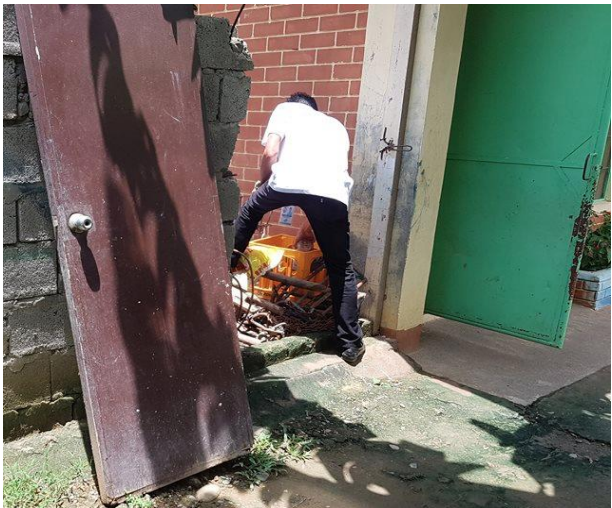
WHEREAS, in accordance with policy, there is an urgency for the Provincial Government to conduct "TODAS DENGUE, TODO NA 'TO' (IKALIMANG KAGAT)," a systematic and exhaustive multi-sectoral clean-up of public and private spaces, and employ the 4S Strategy as an emergency and pro-active measure to reduce mosquito population, decrease the incidence of dengue fever across the province, prevent deaths from mosquito-borne diseases, and ensure the safety of Isabelenos in their homes and in public places from such diseases;
NOW THEREFORE, I, **FAUSTINO G. DY III**, Governor of the Province of Isabela, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare 15 August 2018, Wednesday, a non-working Holiday in all government and non-government offices in the Province of Isabela for the conduct of clean-up activities to eliminate mosquito breeding sites and stop the spread of dengue fever and other mosquito-borne diseases.
FURTHER, I, **FAUSTINO G. DY III**, hereby direct all local government units, all public and private hospitals, banks, schools and tertiary education institutions, all business establishments, all public and private markets, all government and non-government organizations, all cooperatives, all households, and all members of the private sector in the province of Isabela to 1) employ the 4S Strategy as a Control and Prevention Strategy for Dengue Fever, 2) document the clean-up activities, and 3) submit reports with photographs to the Office of the Governor on the clean-up of gardens, backyards, school compounds, parks, garages, and waterways in all barangays.
FURTHERMORE, the following government offices are hereby ordered to lead in the clean-up drive, enhance information dissemination about the activity, monitor and submit reports of activities undertaken and memoranda issued for the implementation of this Order:

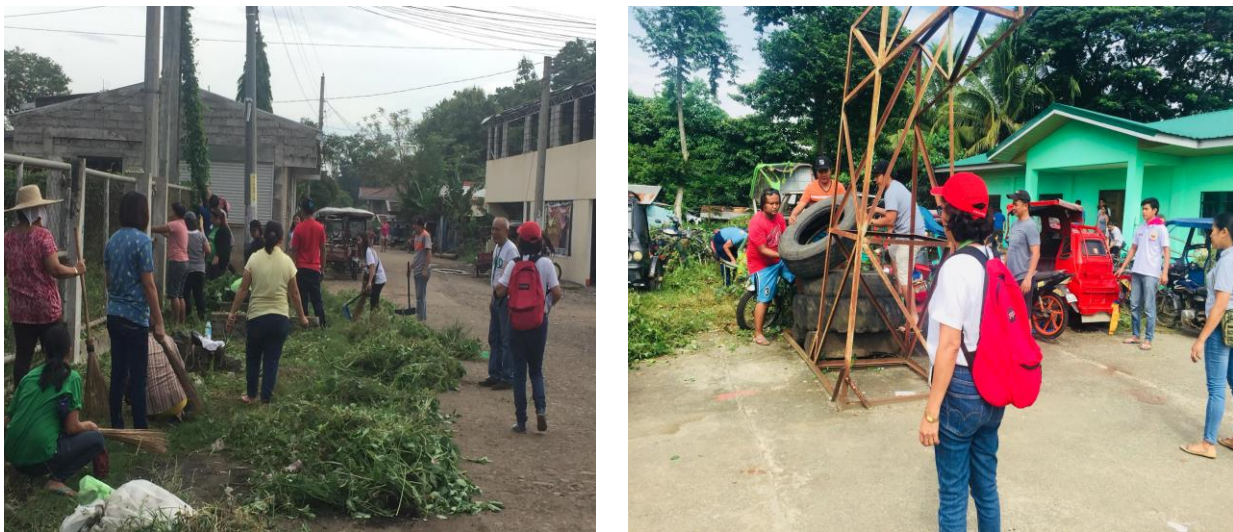
