FAMILY PLANNING SERVICE DELIVERY NETWORK QUARTERLY MEETING

As part of LuzonHealth's technical assistance in developing the capacity of Isabela's Family Planning (FP) Services to achieve zero unmet need on Modern Family Planning, an assessment of FP Services by the Southern Isabela Medical Center (SIMC) in Santiago City was conducted last April 5, 2019.

The participants were representatives of the Provincial DOH Office, Provincial Health Office, Southern Isabela Medical Center, Echague District Hospital, Cauayan District Hospital, the 15 city and Municipal Health Offices, and the Integrated Midwives Association of the Philippines (IMAP).

The activity aims to: monitor and evaluate the operations of the organized FP Service Delivery Network (SDN) and the implementation of the referral mechanism for FP services using the SDN M&E tools, discuss with and present to the DOH RO/PDOHO, PHO, and SDN members the results of the M&E conducted to improve and sustain the operations of the FP SDN and its referral mechanism, a review of minutes from the previous SDN meeting last December 5, 2018, and a presentation of new FP SDN members.

Given the increasing incidence of Measles and Japanese Encephalitis in Region 2, the Isabela Provincial Health Office implemented an Outbreak Response Immunization program; a **Rapid Coverage Assessment** was done in selected cities and municipalities of Isabela to serve as pilot areas. These areas were covered by a vaccination team headed by the Provincial EPI Coordinator Ms Patricia Bagaoisan. The activity ensures that all eligible children were given the measles vaccine.

Given the increasing incidence of Measles in the region, the Provincial Health Office implemented an Outbreak Response Immunization program; Dinapigue is among the included municipalities. However, due to its status as a Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Area (GIDA), the IPHO together with the Cagayan Valley Center for Health Development (CV CHD) decided to conduct a **Rapid Coverage Assessment** last April 10-11, 2019. This was to ensure that all eligible children were given the measles vaccine.

Date: April 24 2019 Venue: Community Center, Benito Soliven, Isabela


This year's Buntis Congress theme: "Sapat at Tamang Pag-aalaga kay Mommy, Proteksyon at Kalusugan ni Baby" aimed to uplift the lives of pregnant women and their unborn children by providing information on maternal and child care in order to ensure optimal health throughout pregnancy.

The Provincial Health Office team were the resource speakers on Maternal and Dental Health; specifically discussing topics on safe motherhood, importance of breastfeeding, completion of child's immunization, methods on Family Planning, and oral care during pregnancy in the Congress held at Benito Soliven. Additionally, the team also took the opportunity to expand awareness on prenatal care, facility based delivery, antenatal, postnatal, and neonatal care.

Representatives from the PhilHealth Office in Region 2 discussed maternity packages to members and encouraged non-members to join and avail immediate benefits.

The program ended with the distribution of Buntis Kits to the 103 participants. Prenatal and dental check ups with laboratory services were conducted by the MHO as well during the event.
