As part of the group visiting towns and cities across the Province, the Public Safety Office continues to disseminate necessary reading materials to create awareness on a grassroots level and demonstrate safety tips thru visual aids and the support of the Bureau of Fire Protection and the Dart 831 rescue team.

The Office, tasked to facilitate and monitor the planning and operations of the PNP-PDRRMC Quick Response Motorcycle Riders, by virtue of Executive Order #18, series of 2014 continues to work with various Government agencies such as the Land Transportation Office, Highway Patrol Group, and the Philippine National Police to craft countermeasures against Road Safety Hazards by spreading awareness and the enforcement of existing Philippine Road Safety Laws thru our deputized Law Enforcement Operatives. As part of it's continuous education for LEO's (Law Enforcement Operatives), seminars are being conducted to make certain that new Laws such are explained in detail to ensure understanding of it's implementing rules and regulations and for LEO's to fully observe the same during operations.


PROVINCIAL PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER

As part of its aim to provide continuous education and skills enhancement of it's workforce, the Public Safety Office sent one of it's staff members to attend the 3 day RDANA - Rapid Disaster Assessment and Needs Analysis training conducted last February 21-23, 2017 at Punta Amelita Resort, Cordon, Isabela. select together with representatives of various agencies of the Provincial Government of Isabela whose line of work is essential to Disaster Management, Risk Reduction Planning, as well as Rescue, Recovery and Rehabilitation.

The training batch was composed of groups from Region II and was facilitated by the Regional Office of Civil Defense, based in Tuguegarao City, Cagayan.

After the initial introduction and presentation of the RDANA concept, which mainly deals with quick response and deployment of reconnaissance teams from various Government agencies and resources to determine the immediate needs of those affected by disasters and act as a medium between ground operatives and the command center, the trainees from different provinces were grouped into 5 teams to promote cooperation across all provinces within the region for the planning, deployment and simulation exercises . Team composition and area assignment was discussed and agreed upon per team while waiting for the disaster scenario.





