For the month of March 2017, the Public Safety Office participated in various activities of the Provincial Government of Isabela such as the 2nd Isabela Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council Summit, Provincial and Regional Peace and Order Council and PDRRM Council meetings, 1st Quarter National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill, Internal Quality Audit trainings among other daily tasks and responsibilities. As part of the group visiting towns and cities across the Province, the Public Safety Office continues to disseminate necessary reading materials to create awareness on a grassroots level and demonstrate safety tips thru visual aids and the support of the Bureau of Fire Protection and the Dart 831 rescue team.

The Office, tasked to facilitate and monitor the planning and operations of the PNP-PDRRMC Quick Response Motorcycle Riders, by virtue of Executive Order #18, series of 2014 continues to work with various Government agencies such as the Land Transportation Office, Highway Patrol Group, and the Philippine National Police to craft countermeasures against Road Safety Hazards by spreading awareness and the enforcement of existing Philippine Road Safety Laws thru our deputized Law Enforcement Operatives. As part of it's continuous education for LEO's (Law Enforcement Operatives), seminars are being conducted to make certain that new Laws such are explained in detail to ensure understanding of it's implementing rules and regulations and for LEO's to fully observe the same during operations.

With the help of our Dart 831 counterparts, a demo on how to prepare survival kits and Go bags was presented, together with a trivia question and answer portion wherein the audience and visitors were able to participate and show their awareness on Safety and disaster preparedness.

The PSO go bag / survival kit is composed of the following:Food and water ra-

tion for 2-3 days (canned goods)

- Small bills
- Cooking/eating utensils for each member of the family
- Safety box/plastic for important documents/ Family member contact numbers
- First-aid kit (Bandages/ medicine supplements)
- Emergency numbers (posted/laminated on the side of the go bag)
- Matches and Candle, Swiss knife
- Analog cellphone/flashlight with radio capability and batteries

The Go Bag, PSO umbrellas and other Public Safety Office giveaways were awarded to the audience who participated

in the trivia question and answer portion. Isabela singing sensation Rufino "Fin" Ramirez also lent a hand in the presentation as he sang twice to the delight of the whole Capitol audience.
