The Office joined Road Safety Council activities, monitored the deployment of the 2nd batch of PNP -PDRRMC Isabela Provincial Police Motorcycle

Unit and reviewed existing applicable laws and ordinances for implementation as well as reiterated Standard Operating Procedures in apprehension and Law Enforcement.

The Public Safety Office, in full coordination with the ISABELA POLICE PROVINCIAL OFFICE, conducted a series of trainings and consultative meetings with the Road Safety Council as well as the 2 batches of Isabela Police Motorcycle Rescue Unit to further enhance their capabilities, knowledge and streamline the process on Road Safety Law enforcement.

Lectures on Law Enforcement Officer Standard Operating Procedures, Guidelines on apprehending Driving Under the Influence of Drugs / Driving under the influence of Alcohol offenders (RA 10586), Guidelines on issuing Temporary Operator’s Permit, Guidelines on Filing Criminal Cases as well as reviews of existing National

and Local Laws and Ordinances were conducted throughout the month facilitated by Land Transportation Office representatives, Public Safety Officer and Assistant Public Safety Officer to ensure proper understanding and hassle free implementation of the Road Safety Laws across the Province.

Updated copies of existing Laws and Ordinances and the Laws and Ordinances Handbook which is a part of the Road Safety Program of the Provincial Government of Isabela were reviewed and distributed to each member of the Road Safety Council as well as the members of the Isabela Police Motorcycle Unit.

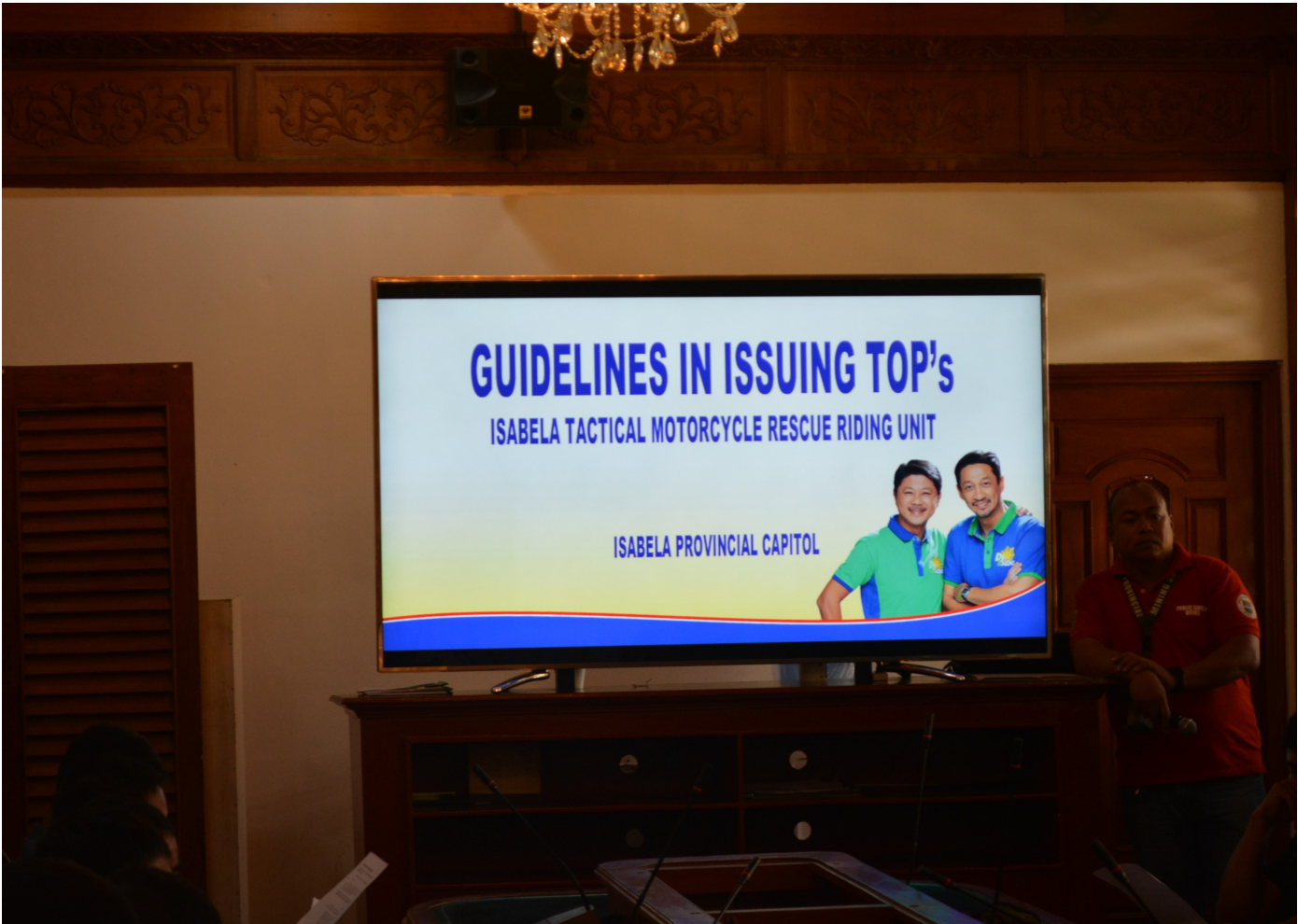

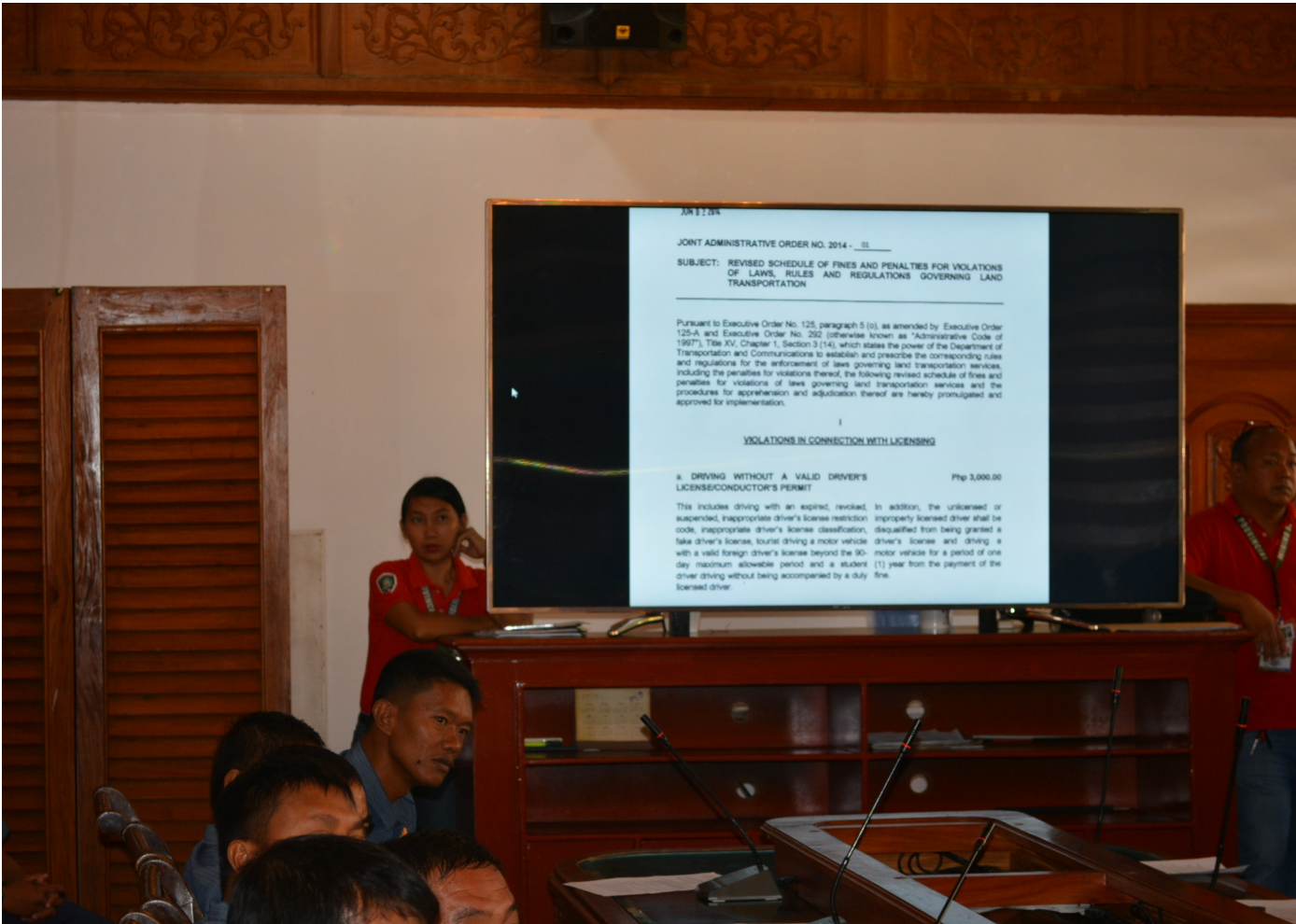
