A full operational section, training and logistics section, new tasks and responsibilities, a new realm for the 10 year old PGI Department. A glimpse of the 2024 Public Safety Office.

A. Changes in the organiza-

Conferment of full Department Head status to Public Order and Safety Officer Kim Patrick G. Agbayani, personnel promotions, reorganization and establishment of new sections. Due to this development, new responsibilities and designations have been adjusted and reflected in the Organizational structure of the Office.

B. PGI BRO ASSISTANCE DISTRIBUTION

The Public Safety Office actively provides aid to BRO Assistance Distribution. Its main goal is to help in QUEUE MANAGEMENT, CROWD CONTROL and SAFETY IEC distribu-

tion during the multiple events. The Public Safety Office for CY 2024 assisted 24 PGI BRO ASSISTANCE DISTRIBUTION events around the Province of Isabela and distributed a total of 60,000 safety IECs.

C. Safety Officer Training / Continuous Learning

The Provincial Government. in it's commitment to provide necessary learning on safety procedures and increase the PGI workforce's capacity in terms of Safety Awareness and Safety Officer roster, has successfully trained 43 First Responders to replace transferred / inactive / retired members. The trainings were conducted in 2 batches starting the month of October with the last batch of training conducted on December. A 1 day LTO Deputation workshop/ training was also held for the 35 iSMART riders as part of their annual requirement for renewal of their credentials

with the Land Transportation Office as deputized Law Enforcement Operatives.

D. Isabela Local Public Transport Route Plan

With Public Order and Safety Officer Kim Patrick G. Agbayani at the helm as Co-Chairman of the iLPTRP Team by virtue of GRTA EO 13, series of 2024, PSO personnel, together with partner LPTRP-Technical Working Group submitted the initial Local Public Transport Plan for the Province last 2024. The document has been reviewed by the DOTr and LTFRB Regional Office 2 since then and was returned to the Technical Working Group with comments to update the applicable references found on the document and align the formatting of some tables according to the new LPTRP manual. To date, the document is being prepared for re-submission.



THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE

Isabela Public The Safety Office traces its humble beginnings to February 21, 2012, when Ordinance No. 001 Series of "AN ORDI-2012, entitled NANCE CREATING AND ES-**TABLISHING** THE **DEPART-**MENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY IN THE **PROVINCIAL GOVERN-**MENT OF ISABELA AND PROVIDING FUNDS THERE-FOR" authored by Sangguni-Panlalawigan Member ang Rolando L. Tugade. Chairman of the Committee on Public Security and Order, was enacted.

It was later amended by Ordinance No. 002. Series of 2014, entitled "ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE OF THE PRO-VINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ISABELA AND **PROVIDING** FUNDS THEREFOR", authored by Sangguniang Panlalawigan Member Hon. Karen G. Abuan, Chairman, Committee on Laws, Rules and Regulations.

The functions of the Office:

(a) To enforce provisions of Ordinance No. 0002-2001 otherwise known as the Provincial Administrative Code, particularly Chapter IV, Provincial Government Services: Article 1 – Peace, Order, and Security; Article 2 – Public Order; Article 3 – Safety on Public Roads; and Article 4 – Safety on Fire Hazards;

- (b) To enforce provisions of Presidential Decree No. 1566 governing the creation of Provincial Disaster Coordinating Council in the Province of Isabela now called the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (PDRRMC) under R.A. 10121;
- (c) To enforce all other laws and ordinances relative to the protection of lives and properties, and those pertaining but not limited to the maintenance of public safety, peace and order especially during man-made or natural calamities, and the promotion of general welfare;
- (d) To ensure and provide quick response and coordinative efforts for any call or need of the public for police, fire marshals, rescue or medical assistance;
- (e) Exercise the duty to make citizen's arrest pursuant to the Rules of Court: and
- (f) Perform such other duties and functions as may be provided by law or ordinance. (Section 5, Ordinance No. 01-2014)

The Office was initially manned by Atty. Constante A. Foronda, Jr. as the Department Head, PBGEN. Jimmy U. Rivera, Sr., (Ret.) the former Provincial Director of Isabela Police Provincial Office (IPPO) as Assistant Department Head and Mr. Jose Armand G. Araneta.

Nine (9) years since its creation on January 21, 2014, Public Safety Office has evolved into what it is now. It initially shared office space with the Office of the Governor, until the District Office of then 1st District Representative Hon. Rodolfo "Rodito" T. Albano (Incumbent Governor of Isabela) was graciously offered to be its temporary office, prior to being transferred to the former office of the Provincial Cooperatives Development Office (PCDO) at the rear ground floor of the Isabela Provincial Capitol from 2017 to 2019 before transferring to its current location at 2nd floor of the newly constructed PSO-PSWDO Building, Provincial Capitol Grounds, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela on December 2019.

THE PSO SHIELD

The PSO Shield was designed to formally establish the identity and purpose of the Public Safety Office which was created by virtue of Sangguniang Panlalawigan Ordinance No. 002 series of 2014 on January 21, 2014.



THE SHIELD The shield signifies protection from danger, risk, or any unpleasant experience.

Black Color of the Shield Signifies unity and power, strength.

The Map is in green color indicating the Map of Isabela province's status as one of the top corn and rice producers of the country. It is presented with demarcation lines indicating 34 towns and 2 component cities which makes it the 2nd largest province of the Philippines. It was initially called *Isabela de Luzon* to differentiate from other places within the Country bearing the name of Isabela. The province was named after Queen Isabela II of Spain.

The Official Seal The Official Seal of Isabela is super imposed on top of the Malta Cross and Star of Life to signify the province's readiness to respond in all types of emergencies.

The Maltese Cross

Symbolizes the good traits of a safety officer as being observant, tactful, resourceful, dexterous, explicit, discriminating, perseverant and sympathetic.


Star of Life

is a blue, six-pointed star, outlined with a white border which features the rod of Asclepius in the center. Traditionally, the logo was used as a stamp of authentication or certification for ambulances, paramedics or other EMS personnel. Internationally, it represents emergency medical services units and personnel.

The Four Connected Hands is a symbol of togetherness and participation. It signifies the unity of various units within the government working hand in hand to ensure the safety and well-being of its residents.

The People

A group of 36 persons, representing the 34 towns and 2 component cities of the Province of Isabela linking together, to provide a full and unified front against all adversities and elements that may compromise the safety and well-being of its residents.

PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE ACCOMPLISHMENTS FOR THE YEAR

Although the Public Safety Office responds to safety and/ or order events with the coordination with police, fire, rescue, medical, and social welfare groups, it prides itself in taking a proactive stance that focuses on providing solutions to problems before they even arise. This is done through recommendations by the Public Safety Office to the proper agencies on matters pertaining to the personal safety and security of Isabeleños in times of calamities and disasters, crime waves, terrorism and other forms of security threats.

The Office have several accomplishments in the promotion of public safety in 2024. They are the following:

- Caused the training of 2 batches (43 trained) of PGI Safety Officers to replace transferred / inactive / retired members and provide continuous learning and development for our existing core of PGI Safety Officers.
- Joined and supported the Quarterly National Simultaneous Earthquake drills in full coordination with the Office of Civil Defense - Region 2, PDRRMO, BFP and other aligned agencies.



- Submit recommendations/ situational reports to the Provincial Governor regarding matters concerning Public Safety and Public Order.
- 4) Monitored and updated the Isabela Emergency Hotlines Quarterly for the benefit of all Isabela residents and visitors who might have a need for Police, Firemen and General Rescue assistance.
- 5) Facilitated / attended coordinating meetings and conferences with different line agencies, such as but not limited to Seal of Good Local Governance preparation and presentation and liaised with other departments with regards to Safety, Traffic, Parking, Security and

Crowd Control arrangements for all PGI major events within the Provincial Capitol grounds and other areas within the Province.

- 6) Continuous production and research of IEC materials as per request and public requirement. Distributed approximately 60000++ units of various safety related flyers across the 36 LGUs within the Province.
- 7) As part of its mandate, PSO personnel joins various PGI assistance distribution activities such as Bro Scholarship Assistance Distribution, Tupad, iRISE and Tobacco Excise Tax distribution throughout the Province to ensure the safety of participants and hosts alike.

PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE ACCOMPLISHMENTS FOR THE YEAR

In Full coordination with the Provincial Cooperative Livelihood and Development Office (PCLEDO), Public Employment Services Office (PESO), Provincial Youth and Development Office (PYDO), Bro Office, General Services Office (GSO), Provincial Security Group (PSG) and the Provincial Governor's Office (PGO) PSO personnel provide assistance in Crowd-control, Queue Management and General Public Safety and distribute Safety IEC/Flyers during the events held across the Province.

- 8) PSO personnel attended various capacity building seminars and workshops to further improve skills and knowledge on Safety such as Incident Command System training for Executives, Civil Service Commission Regional Office 2 free online trainings, Two-way radio communication and Radio Etiquette training, among others.
- 9) PSO personnel acted as support/ augmentation contingent during severe weather related disturbances and assisted PDRRMO counterparts, PSWDO counterparts in their water level monitoring, rescue and relief operations as reserve pilots while POSO Agbayani led road clearing operations together with the 1st and 2nd PMFC, BFP-Isabela, PSO and Dart 831 personnel.
- 10) PSO intensifies Public Information and Awareness on Public Safety Guidelines and procedures through it's Social Media page https://www.facebook.com/pgipso, and currently maintains the PGI Safety Officer core messaging group for important updates such as Emergency Hotline Distribution, PGI important communications.
- 11) PSO personnel, as part of the Isabela Local Public Transport Route Planning Technical Working Group (iLPTRP-TWG) continue to study and craft the LPTRP document/plan and be ready for re-

submission to LTFRB and DOTr.

- 12) PSO, led by Public Order and Safety Officer Kim Patrick G. Agbayani was able to spearhead Gun Safety activities by hosting the License to Own and Possess Firearm (LTOPF) and Firearm Registration Caravan at Isabela Emergency Operations Center, Provincial Capitol. This initiative is part of the general plan of full coordination with the Philippine National Police and other aligned agencies in promoting Gun Safety among it's constituents.
- 13) PSO personnel started managing and maintaining Employee and Public Parking areas within Provincial Capitol Grounds for major PGI events. 7 parking personnel are on a daily rotation schedule manning identified parking areas to assist visitors/clients and employees.
- 14) Public Order and Safety Officer Kim Patrick G. Agbayani was awarded Gintong Agila, Public Service Award from Brigada- Pahayagang Malaya's Wilfredo "Jun" Berganio.
- 15) PSO provides crowd-control and security assistance during major PGI events, Isabela's Got Talent competition among other events held at the Provincial Capitol premises.



ISABELA EMERGENCY HOTLINES UPDATES AND POSTING

The Public Safety Office, as part of it's mandate, is responsible for gathering emergency numbers from the local Rescue Teams, Bureau of Fire Protection and the Police Precints in different Municipalities and Cities of The Province of Isabela, The Public Safety Office routinely calls these hotline numbers to make sure that EMERGENCY HOTLINE NUMBERS posted are accurate and up to date.

The Public Safety Office quarterly updates its emergency hotline numbers and prints and distributes them to PGI departments PGI service vehicles and incorporates them in the Safety IEC Flyer distributed during PGI assistance distribution and seminars hosted by the Public Safety Office, it is posted in the PSOs Social Media page and forwarded to the Provincial Information Office for widest dissemination, especially during typhoon and holidays wherein having an emergency hotline number would be in handy. The Quarterly updated hotlines are also posted at different major public transport convergence points like malls, public markets and transport terminals around the Province of Isabela.





PSO PARTICIPATION ON PGI EVENTS

TAIWAN AMBASSADOR VISIT:

Taiwan Ambassador, His Excellency Wallace Minn-Gan Chow's historic visit to the Province of Isabela on February 18, 2024, marked a significant milestone in strengthening bilateral relations between Taiwan and the Philippines. Ambassador Chow was warmly received by Provincial Officials led by Governor Rodolfo T. Albano III and Vice Governor Faustino G. Dy III.

The visit aimed to promote agricultural cooperation, tourism, and livelihood initiatives. Ambassador Chow and his delegation explored potential partnerships in agricultural modernization, visiting key sites such as the Isabela State University's Cagayan Valley Cacao Processing Center (CVCPC), Sagittarius Agricultural Philippines, Inc., Charoen Pokphand Foods Phils., and Mr. Moo's Dairy Farm and Processing Center.

Taiwan's expertise in agricultural technology and innovation was showcased during the visit. The CVCPC's facilities, equipped with state-of-the-art machinery, impressed the delegation. Discussions centered around establishing the Taiwan Technical Mission Demonstration Farm in Isabela, following the success of the Tarlac City model.

MOTORCYCLE ENDURANCE: IMPLEMENTATION OF ROAD SAFETY LAWS AND ORDINANCES

The Public Safety Office of Isabela Province has demonstrated exemplary commitment to safeguarding its citizens, particularly in enforcing road safety regulations. Led by Public Order and Safety Officer Kim Patrick G. Agbayani, the office conducted inspections and established checkpoints in various towns and cities on April 14, 2024, during the "A Scooter Motorcycle Endurance event. This non-coordinated event, involving over 800 participants, posed significant risks due to excessive speed and noisy mufflers.

Key Concerns and Actions:

- Unregistered Vehicles: Multiple participants were apprehended for operating unregistered motorcycles, lacking official receipts (OR) and certificates of registration (CR), and driving with expired licenses.
- Speed Limit Enforcement: Checkpoints helped monitor and control speeds, mitigating potential accidents.
- Noisy Mufflers: The office addressed concerns about excessive noise pollution.

In contrast, the **Burgos Eco Tour** on May 16, 2024, also involving a motorcycle endurance challenge showcased effective coordination between event organizers and the Public Safety Office. This collaboration ensured seamless deployment of personnel and assistance to participants, guaranteeing adherence to public safety protocols.

Another "Motorcycle Endurance Challenge" on December 8, 2024, which attempted to pass through Isabela without coordination, prompted the Public Safety Office to conduct random checkpoints. This proactive approach led to the apprehension of two violators for over-speeding and operating unregistered motorcycles.

These efforts by the Public Safety Office are grounded in the implementation of current laws and ordinances for road safety, specifically Executive Order No. 18 and Republic Act 4136 of the Land Transportation Office. These measures aim to ensure

public safety, prevent accidents, and promote responsible driving practices.

The Public Safety Office's proactive stance on road safety serves as a model for other local governments. By enforcing regulations, engaging with event organizers, and educating the public, Isabela Province demonstrates its commitment to protecting its citizens and visitors.



NATIONAL SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL

On March 22, 2024, The Public Safety Office participated in the 1st Quarter National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill. Employees and clients of the Provincial Government of Isabela were successfully led by respective Safety Officers to the designated evacuation area as part of the Office of Civil Defense initiated Pilot National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill for the 1st Quarter of the year.

our performance in the aforementioned exercise in which the aim was to showcase the Province's readiness, discipline and cooperation and to share best practices on unique qualities/capabilities such as having a designated Safety Officer core (SO 1-4) per department which acts as additional manpower, primarily responsible for the evacuation and overall safety of co-employees and clients alike during evacuation proceedings.

PSO Agbayani and personnel performed assigned duties together with Incident Command Post leaders and counterparts

At exactly 9:00 AM, the sirens were heard to raise the alarm and indicate simulated ground shaking. All departments were to perform the "Duck, Cover and Hold" procedure and based on this simulation, proceed to the evacuation centre 30 seconds after the supposed "ground shaking" period.

PGI employees were observed to perform accordingly and the Safety Officers were properly able to account for employee and visitor head-count once called upon at the Incident Command Post. PSO Personnel put up a canopy and chairs for PWDs, Pregnant and Senior Citizens in the open area directly facing the Balai Guest House, Isabela Provincial Capitol.

Dart 831 high-angle rescue techniques (rope and rappel), and vehicular accident extraction, among other search and rescue (SAR) disciplines, were showcased during the exercise.

The EQ drill was concluded in approximately 47 minutes for all areas upon recommendation by the engineering personnel, who deemed all the buildings/offices within Capitol grounds safe as part of the procedure. Employees in the main evacuation area were sent back around 9:47 AM, 47 minutes after the start of the exercise. PGI Safety Officers submitted their respective After-Incident reports and photo documentation attachments for consolidation.

On June 28, 2024, The Public Safety Office participated in the **2nd Quarter National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill.**

At exactly 9:00 AM, the sirens from the lobby of the Capitol Building, PDRRMC Ambulances, BFP Firetrucks around the Capitol Complex were heard to raise the alarm and indicate simulated ground

shaking. All departments were able to perform the "Duck, Cover and Hold" procedure based on this simulation, and proceeded to the evacuation area after the siren stopped indicating the supposed "ground shaking" period.

PGI employees were observed to perform accordingly, and the Safety Officers were properly able to account for employee and visitor headcounts once called upon at the Incident Command Post in the open area directly facing the Balai Guest House, Isabela Provincial Capitol.

PSO personnel were assigned specific sectors/areas to cover for all offices located within the Capitol grounds and relayed information using 2-way radio communication to the Incident Command Post.

The EQ drill was concluded in approximately 25 minutes for all areas upon recommendation by the engineering personnel, who deemed all the buildings/offices within Capitol grounds safe as part of the procedure. Employees in the main evacuation area were sent back around 9:25 AM, or 25 minutes after the start of the exercise. PGI Safety Officers submitted their After-Incident reports and photo documentation

On September 26, 2024, The Public Safety Office participated in the **3rd Quarter National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill.**

At exactly 9:00 AM, the sirens from the lobby of the Capitol Building, PDRRMC Ambulances, and BFP Firetrucks around the Capitol Complex were heard to raise the alarm and indicate simulated ground shaking. All departments were able to perform the "Duck, Cover and Hold" procedure based on this simulation, and proceeded to the evacuation area after the siren stopped indicating the supposed "ground shaking" period.

Public Order and Safety Officer Kim Patrick G. Agbayani acted as the Incident Commander; Public Services Officer IV Manuel Cesar G. Binag IV acted as the Safety Officer; with Provincial Administrator Noel Manuel R. Lopez as the Responsible Official at the Incident Command Post; Provincial Fire Marshall FSSupt. Atty. Archie R. Andumang, BFP Personnel, DART 831 Personnel and other Command Staff.

PGI employees were observed to perform accordingly and the PGI Safety Officers were properly able to account for employee and visitor headcount once called upon at the Incident Command Post at the Evacuation Area.

PSO personnel were assigned specific sectors/ areas to cover all offices within Capitol grounds and relayed information using Twoway radio to the Incident Command Post.

The EQ drill was concluded in approximately 36 minutes for all areas upon recommendation by the engineering personnel, who deemed all the buildings/offices within Capitol grounds safe as part of the procedure. Employees in the main evacuation area were sent back around 9:36 AM, 36 minutes after the start of the exercise. PGI Safety Officers submitted their After-Incident reports and photo documentation attachments for consolidation.

On November 14, 2024, the Provincial Government of Isabela was unable to participate in the 4th Quarter National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill due to Super Typhoon "Ofel" (Usagi), which affected the Province of Isabela and Cagayan province.
