## Activities undertaken from November 3-7, 2014

I. Orientation on Unlad Kabataan Program for the Youth - Ms. Charmiya Rosalina L. Cruz.

The participants were oriented on the Unlad Kabataan Program with detailed information, its By-Laws, History, Steps on Organizing the PYA (Pre-organizing and Organizing) both at the Municipal and Baranagay level and other related topics about the program.

To date, there are 16,000 scholars, more or less, enrolled in different campuses of the Isabela State University and Philippine Normal University – Isabela, some scholars were enrolled in other Universities like the University of the Philippines, Central Luzon State University, Cagayan State university, etc.

The BRO for Education is a manifests of the dream of the governor, Honorable Faustino G. Dy, III to have one scholar in every Isabeleño family because more than anything else, the Dy-Albano administration believes that education is the solution for progress and continuous unity for the Province of Isabela.
