## PTO IN ACTION

***(March 10-14, 2014)***

- **March 10, 2014** - The Office of the Provincial Treasurer was able to collect the Franchise Tax due for CY 2014 (based on CY 2013 distribution charges) from the Isabela-I Electric Cooperative, Inc. (ISELCO I) in the total amount of P1,316,645.07, including Governor's Permit Fee. ISELCO I has been a major contributor of collections from local sources of the province particularly on Franchise Tax.
- **March 11, 2014 – Farmers' Congress sa Barangay held at Delfin Albano, Isabela**  
Provincial Treasurer Maria Theresa Araneta-Flores led the PTO Group in the recently concluded Farmers' Congress sa Barangay held at Delfin Albano, Isabela last March 11, 2014.

Checks representing Aid to Barangays in the amount of P100,000.00 per barangay, totalling to P 2,900,000.00, were released to the 29 Barangays of Delfin Albano. Said checks were awarded by Hon. Governor Faustino G. Dy III together with Hon. Vice Governor Antonio T. Albano to the Barangay Captains. In addition, the duly processed BRO livelihood assistance checks for 4 individuals in the total amount of P 12,000.00 were also released. Moreover, the PTO Team also handed to the respective Treasurers the total amount of P45,000.00 representing Financial Assistance for Municipal/Barangay Festivals.
