VETERINARY SERVICES IN FARMERS' CONGRESS, A BIG HIT

One of the services flocked by many farmer-raisers during Farmers' Congress is the Veterinary Services being rendered by the Provincial Veterinary Office (PVET Office).

Usually after registration, many farmers line up in tent no. 17 to avail of the veterinary services which include the following:

- Free Dewormers for Carabaos, Cattle, Goat and Sheep
- Free Vitamins and Antibiotics for Swine and Poultry
- Free Rabies Vaccination of Dogs

From February 27 – June 20, 2014, the PVET Office has already covered 14 municipalities, served 3,316 farmer-raisers, dewormed 6,369 cattle, carabaos and goats, gave vitamins for 67,342 swine and poultry and vaccinated 425 dogs against rabies.
