IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15, DATED AUGUST 16, 2010

Pursuant to Section 1 of Executive Order no. 15 dated August 16, 2010, otherwise known as the Special Project Committee on Health Care Program, following rules and regulations are hereby adopted:

PART I

RULE I Guiding Principle

Section 11 Article XIII of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines declares that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all people at affordable cost. Priority for the needs of underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women and children shall be recognized. Likewise, it shall be the policy of the State to provide for medical care to paupers.

RULE II Preliminary Provisions

Section 1. This Executive Order shall be known and cited as the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Isabela Provincial HealthCare.

Section 2. Purpose - This Executive Order is being promulgated to prescribe the procedure and guidelines for the smooth and successful implementation of the Isabela Provincial HealthCare.

Section 3. Construction - This Executive Order shall be liberally construed to carry out the policy of the new administration on the implementation of the Isabela Provincial Health Care.

Section 4. Administration and Enforcement - This implementing rules shall be administered by the Office of the HealthCare Manager pursuant to Section 7 Rule IV hereof

Rule III Declaration of Policy

Section 5. Objectives of the HealthCare - Among others and pursuant to Section 1 of Executive Order No. 15, dated August 16, 2010, it shall be the objectives of the Isabela Provincial HealthCare, viz;

- 1. Provide all bona fide residents of Isabela the mechanism to gain access to quality health care services.
- 2. Prioritize and accelerate the provision of health care services to all permanent residents of Isabela especially that segment of the population who can not afford quality health care services.
- 3. To eliminate usurious transaction with private lender due to partial or insufficient claim payments by PhilHealth and other existing health plans and other health management organizations.
- 4. Provide a decent and state of the art treatment procedure from hospitals operated by the provincial government of Isabela and referral to hospitals selected and accredited by the provincial government locally and in Metro Manila.
