HOSPITAL PROFILE

The Cauayan District Hospital is a government owned and operated hospital under the leadership of Gov. Rodolfo T. Albano III, Provincial Governor, Isabela. It is a Level I Health facility with an Authorized Bed Capacity (ABC) of 50 beds while it's Actual / Implementing Beds reaches 100 beds.

Cauayan District Hospital is a Philippine Hospital Association member in good standing, PhilHealth (PHIC) and Animal Bite Treatment Center (ABTC) accredited.

The institution has been serving as the core-referral hospital previously of District III municipalities and after Cauayan City was reapportioned to District VI, additional municipalities are now being catered to. This does not prevent however, non-member municipalities from bringing in their patients for various health care services.

In order to be more responsive and effective to the changes and challenges of times and to the constantly increasing demands for affordable healthcare services from our clientele, the Cauayan District Hospital envisions to be operational as One Hundred (100) bed capacity hospital.


