
N. OTHER ACTIVITIES & ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- d. June 24, 2024 – The MARDH personnel conducted General Cleaning within the vicinity of the hospital.


June 24, 2024 – The Provincial Engineering Office personnel back filled the front of our Hemodialysis center thru Engr. Gomez.
