EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 51

Series of 2019

DECLARING 31 OCTOBER 2019, THURSDAY, A SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAY IN ALL GOVERNMENT AND NON-GOVERNMENT OFFICES IN THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA TO AFFORD ISABELENOS TIME AND OPPORTUNITY TO TRAVEL TO THE PLACE OF THE GRAVES OF THEIR DEAD ANCESTORS AND CONDUCT CLEAN UP AND PERFORM MAINTENANCE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, by virtue of Proclamation No. 555 series of 2018, November 1 and 2 of every year, more commonly known among Filipinos as All Saints and All Souls day or collectively referred to as Undas, has been declared as special nonworking holidays by the President of the Republic of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, it has been a tradition among Catholics to celebrate the feast of Saints who were not awarded their own feast days and the following day to pay their respects for their dead;

WHEREAS, in observance of Undas, Catholics would normally visit the cemeteries few days before the actual holidays and prepare the tombs and the graves of their dead by conducting clean ups, repainting and perform maintenance activities;

WHEREAS, some of us would travel back home to our respective provinces or municipalities of origin where our dead are buried a day or two before Undas to afford us time to do our clean up and maintenance;

NOW THEREFORE, I, RODOLFO T. ALBANO III, Governor of the Province of Isabela, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby:

DECLARE 31 OCTOBER 2019, THURSDAY, A SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAY IN ALL GOVERNMENT AND NON-GOVERNMENT OFFICES IN THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA TO AFFORD ISABELENOS TIME AND OPPORTUNITY TO TRAVEL TO THE PLACE OF THE TOMBS AND GRAVES OF THEIR DEAD ANCESTORS AND CONDUCT CLEAN UP AND PERFORM MAINTENANCE THEREOF.
