AN ORDINANCE RECLASSIFYING A PROVINCIAL ROAD LOCATED IN CALAMAGUI 2ND, ILAGAN CITY, ISABELA, PARTICULARLY ALONG THE DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES TO PETRON GASOLINE STATION, TO A CITY ROAD UNDER THE CONTROL, MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISION OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ILAGAN, ISABELA

AN ORDINANCE RECLASSIFYING A PROVINCIAL ROAD LOCATED IN CALAMAGUI 2TM, ILAGAN CITY, ISABELA, PARTICULARLYALONG THE DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES TO PETRON GASOLINE STATION, TO A CITY ROADUNDER THE CONTROL, MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISION OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ILAGAN, ISABELA

WHEREAS, the fast-improving competitiveness of the City Government of Ilagan, Isabela resulted in the influx of individuals, automobiles, and establishments which lead to busier roads and heavier traffic;

WHEREAS, in line with the growing fiscal capacity and administrative capability of the City Government of Ilagan, Isabela, this Body, with consultations and dialogue with the officials of the said City Government, deemed it proper and mutually beneficial to both Local Governments to devolve the management, control, and supervision of a provincial road located in Calamagui 2nd, Ilagan City, Isabela to the latter;

WHEREFORE, premises considered, and by virtue of the powers vested by law, it is hereby resolved to enact —

AN ORDINANCE RECLASSIFYING A PROVINCIAL ROAD LOCATED IN CALAMAGUI 2ND, ILAGAN CITY, ISABELA, PARTICULARLY ALONG THE DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES TO PETRON GASOLINE STATION, TO A CITY ROAD UNDER THE CONTROL, MANAGEMENT, AND SUPERVISION OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ILAGAN, ISABELA;

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Isabela in regular session assembled:

SECTION 1. The existing Provincial Road located in Calamagui 2nd, Ilagan City, Isabela, situated along a road from the Development Bank of the Philippines to a Petron Gas Station, is hereby converted and reclassified into a City Road.

SECTION 2.The control, maintenance, and supervision of the subject road shall be devolved, from the PGI, to the City Government of Ilagan, Isabela.

SECTION 3. The herein conveyance of the control, maintenance, and supervision is only limited to the existing subject road and its current measurements, and shall not extend beyond the same.

SECTION 4. All costs, including incidental expenses, for the introduction of improvements, and the conduct of road repairs and maintenance shall be exclusively shouldered by the City Government of Ilagan, Isabela.

- a. Improvements referred herein shall be limited to structures and posts which raise the load/vehicle capacity of roads or those which promote road safety.
- b. The determination of the necessity to introduce improvements or to conduct road repairs and maintenance shall be at the sole discretion of the City Government.
- c. Introduction of improvements and the conduct of road repairs and maintenance shall not require the approval of the Provincial Government.

SECTION 5. Both local governments shall reflect in their respective records the reclassification of the subject land from a Provincial Road to a City Road, and other facts relative thereto. In connection to this, a survey to determine the measurements, and metes and bounds of the same road shall be conducted.

SECTION 6. The City Government of Ilagan, Isabela shall observe and comply with the laws and rules regarding easements.

SECTION 7. Conduct of road clearing activities of road blockades or obstructions located outside the subject road shall be subject to the notice and approval of the PGI.

SECTION 8. The PGI reserves it right to nullify the effects of this Ordinance and to restore the original classification of the subject road in case the City Government of llagan, Isabela devotes its use to any other purpose or fails to keep it in adequate condition, without recourse for payment of reimbursement.

SECTION 9. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after compliance with the publication requirements set forth by law.
