#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The Provincial Government of Isabela is dedicated to strengthening its agricultural and veterinary programs to support livestock development and ensure sustainable animal health management. A crucial aspect of this commitment is the enhancement of diagnostic capabilities to prevent and control animal diseases that may impact both the local livestock industry and public health.

The Isabela Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory plays a vital role in identifying and managing animal diseases that could threaten the province's agricultural economy. Strengthening this facility is essential to improving disease detection, response, and prevention strategies.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE REPROGRAMMING OF SIX (6) PROJECTS/PROGRAMS/ACTIVITIES UNDER THE ACCOUNT PGO – OTHER PPAS (CONTINUING), AMOUNTING TO TWO MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-TWO THOUSAND PESOS (₱2,842,000.00), TO THREE (3) PROJECTS/PROGRAMS/ACTIVITIES UNDER THE SAME ACCOUNT

Previously, funds amounting to ₱2,842,000.00 were allocated under *Other Programs/Projects and Activities (Continuing)* for various infrastructure and agricultural initiatives. While these projects are valuable, the pressing need to enhance the province's animal disease control efforts necessitates the reprogramming of these funds.

The reallocation of funds will allow for the procurement of laboratory machines and equipment, acquisition of essential furniture and fixtures, and installation of laboratory signage at the Isabela Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory. These upgrades will significantly improve the laboratory's capacity to diagnose and manage animal diseases more efficiently, safeguarding both the local livestock sector and public health.

Investing in these laboratory enhancements will empower the Provincial Government of Isabela to respond more effectively to emerging animal health threats, ensure the welfare of farmers and livestock owners, and contribute to the long-term stability of the province's agricultural industry.

In view of the foregoing, the approval of this Ordinance is earnestly sought.

To ensure that the resources and development plans of the Provincial Government of Isabela are responsive to the current development issues and that its programs, plans, and activities are effectively implemented, the Governor is hereby empowered to augment or reprogram any savings that may be derived from the herein reprogrammed funds to any item within the same appropriation.

Section 5. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
